KYC (knowing your customer) is very important. Laura spoke highly of Christi and project manager Simeon, "Their responsiveness and level of engagement now during implementation gives me confidence that the support after we go live will be great!"

While there, Laura was a volunteer reservist with the city and county of Honolulu, working side-by-side with first responders and teaching emergency rescue to the public.
